INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF PLANT HEALTH 2020

INTRODUCTION

In December 2018, the United Nations General Assembly declared 2020 the International Year of Plant Health (hereinafter “IYPH”) and invited the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), in collaboration with the International Plant Protection Convention (IPPC), to facilitate the implementation of the International Year. The main objective of the IYPH is to raise global awareness on how protecting plant health can help end hunger, reduce poverty, protect the environment, and boost economic development.

These Graphic Guidelines were designed to support all stakeholders that want to take part in activities and events related to the International Year of Plant Health. Therefore, for consistency, when using the IYPH visual identity you must always comply with these Graphic Guidelines.

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LEGAL

AUTHORIZATION FOR THE USE OF THE VISUAL IDENTITY

The IYPH 2020 visual identity must always be used in its entirety and displayed alongside other visual identity according to the instructions provided in these Guidelines.

NO PRIOR AUTHORIZATION

United Nations (UN) Offices, Funds and Programmes, other subsidiary organs and organizations of the United Nations System, National Plant Protection Organizations (NPPOs) and Regional Plant Protection Organizations (RPPOs) may use the IYPH visual without obtaining prior authorization. However, they are asked to provide information to FAO about their activities for the purpose of monitoring, reporting and increasing global communication impact.

PRIOR AUTHORIZATION REQUIRED

Entities outside the UN system, including governments, intergovernmental organizations, not-for-profit organizations, and private sector entities, may use the IYPH 2020 visual identity only after obtaining approval from the IYPH 2020 Secretariat, in accordance with the requirements provided. The IYPH 2020 visual identity is primarily intended for information purposes.

A) Information uses are those which are:

- Primarily illustrative;
- Not intended to raise funds;
- Not be used for the purpose of self-promotion, or obtaining any commercial or personal financial gain;
- Not be used in any manner which implies United Nations or FAO endorsement of the products, services or activities of a commercial enterprise.

For monitoring and reporting purposes, the IYPH 2020 Secretariat should be informed of events and information materials and items for which the visual identity is used

including, inter alia, publications, posters, brochures, videos, pins, T-shirts, etc.

B) All entities interested in using the IYPH 2020 visual identity for fundraising purposes must also apply for approval to the IYPH 2020 Secretariat. Fundraising uses are those intended to raise resources to cover the costs of activities in support of the International Year of Plant Health (2020).

1. [The waiver of liability](#) form, signed by the entity, must be submitted with the request to use the IYPH 2020 visual identity. The entity cannot carry out the proposed activities using the IYPH 2020 visual identity until the request is approved and the duly signed waiver of liability is received by the joint FAO/IPPC Secretariat.
2. The IYPH 2020 visual identity is property of the UN and the UN owns all rights thereto, including its use.
3. The authorization is limited to the use of the IYPH 2020 visual identity, and thus the United Nations emblem or FAO logo cannot be used. Authorized users are not permitted to sublicense or to further authorize the use of the visual identity to any other entities.
4. The visual identity can be used from January to December 2020. It may be used beyond 2020 only for reporting and in reference to publications about the IYPH 2020.
5. The entity is responsible for ensuring that the activities are carried out in accordance with the applicable law and for ensuring that the appropriate insurance is maintained to cover the risks arising out of such activities. The UN, FAO and IPPC, do not assume any responsibility for the activities of the entity.
6. The entity shall hold harmless and defend the UN, including FAO and IPPC, and their officials against any action that may be brought against the UN, including

FAO and IPPC or their officials as a result of the use of the IYPH 2020 visual identity by the entity.

7. The IYPH 2020 visual identity can only be used to identify events and activities related to the International Year of Plant Health during the year 2020.
8. By using the IYPH 2020 visual identity, the entity agrees to provide information to the joint FAO/IPPC Secretariat on the events or activities for which it is used. This information will be used for reporting purposes.
9. The authorization to use the IYPH 2020 visual identity does not imply the endorsement by the UN, FAO and IPPC of the planned activities.
10. The IYPH 2020 visual identity may not be reproduced for the purpose of self-promotion, or obtaining any commercial or personal financial gain, nor may it be used in any manner that implies endorsement by the UN or FAO of the products or activities of a commercial enterprise.

The UN or FAO will not assume any responsibility or liability arising from the translation of the text of the IYPH 2020 visual identity into non-UN official languages.

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LOGO USAGE

CONCEPT

The IYPH visual identity consists of a symbolic representation of leaves and the text "International Year of Plant Health 2020". The green leaves in the visual identity represent healthy plants as the source of the oxygen we breathe, the food we eat and all life on earth. This positive image of leaves protected from deadly pests and diseases forms a circle which represents the world and underlines how plant health and protection is a global issue. The familiar colour wheel representing the Sustainable Development Goals is present in the zero of "2020". It recalls how plant health is the key to ending hunger, reducing poverty, protecting the environment and boosting economic development, which are all crucial to achieving the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The words "International Year of Plant Health" appear to the side or under the visual image, depending on whether it is the vertical or the horizontal version, and the year "2020" appears underneath, to ensure that there is an understanding that the duration of this campaign is of one year, running from 1 January to 31 December 2020.

The IYPH visual identity comes in two main versions that should be used as much as possible:

Wherever the slogan is used, the visual identity should be present in the same document or material.

HORIZONTAL VERSION

To maintain clarity and legibility, for all six-language versions, the minimum height for the IYPH visual identity is:

- Print: Height = 15 mm
- Web: Height = 45 pixels

There is no maximum reproduction size.

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VERTICAL VERSION

To maintain clarity and legibility, for all six-language versions, the minimum height for the IYPH visual identity is:

- Print: Height = 30 mm
- Web: Height = 90 pixel

There is no maximum reproduction size.

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CLEAR SPACE AROUND GRAPHIC

Vertical

Clear space must be maintained on all sides of the visual identity. This is necessary for it to be perceived as separate from any other elements in the environment in which it appears.



CLEAR SPACE AROUND GRAPHIC

Horizontal

Clear space must be maintained on all sides of the visual identity. This is necessary for it to be perceived as separate from the other elements in the environment in which it appears.

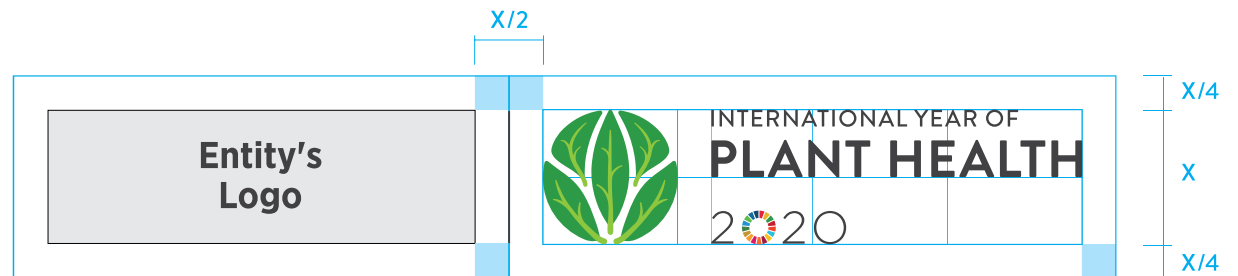


CO-BRANDING

Authorized entities can choose to use the horizontal or vertical version of the IYPH visual identity to brand a product.

In co-branding, the size of the two logos should be harmonized.

A thin black line should be used to separate the logos. The distance between each logo and the line should be equal to the IYPH clear space around the graphic.



MULTIPLE ENTITIES

- a. If the authorized entities have the same level of importance, co-branding rules can be followed.



- b. It's important to clearly separate any secondary entities from main entities and the IYPH visual identity.

If possible, use Brandon Grotesque Black and Bold for headings and Brandon Grotesque Regular for body text. Other weight (Light) are also acceptable.

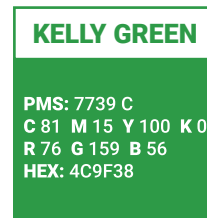

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APPLICATIONS

BACKGROUNDS

The visual identity should always be used in full colour against a solid background, ideally white.

Overlaying it onto busy photography or a background without sufficient contrast is not recommended.

Solid black/white versions have been created as alternatives, but these should only be used when absolutely necessary.
